Getting Started

Install via the Envato (ThemeForest) Plugin

ThemeForest have introduced a new method of updating / installing your Themes. **Download** the following plugin:

Download: https://github.com/envato/envato-wordpress-toolkit/archive/master.zip

This option is the preferred method as it allows you to create **backups** and **upgrade** to future versions.

- You have the option to either ZIP the plugin (if it's not already) upload via the WordPress admin → Plugins → Add New or upload the `envato-wordpress-toolkit` folder to the `/wp-content/plugins/` directory
- 2. Activate the plugin through the `**Plugins**` menu in WordPress.
- 3. To establish an Envato Marketplace API connection navigate to the `Envato Toolkit` page and insert your Marketplace **username** and **secret API key**.
- 4. API key in the designated input fields. To obtain your **API Key**, visit your "My Settings" page on any of the Envato Marketplaces.
- 5. Once the API connection has been established you will see a list of themes that can be auto installed. If you don't see any themes and are certain you've done everything correct, there is a good chance the theme author has not updated their theme to be available for auto install and update. If that's the case, please contact the theme author and ask them to update their theme's information.

Note: If you have already installed the theme using an alternative method and wish to use the Envato toolkit plugin, you will need to remove current version of the Theme from the WordPress admin.

You may want to consider a 'maintenance' plugin whilst you make the change over.

Installing via WordPress Admin

To install a theme correctly, you **MUST UNZIP** the file provided by ThemeForest.

- 1. Now ZIP (compress) **just** the **Tersus** folder. (DO NOT include the Tersus-Wordpress, PSD, Licensing or Tersus-Demo-Data Folders).
- 2. The correct theme folder with have the style.css file within the root. i.e. Tersus/style.css

- 3. The file is now ready to be uploaded via the WordPress admin.
- 4. Go to Appearance \rightarrow Themes and click Install Themes tab
- 5. Click Upload and then Browse to find your theme
- 6. Click the Install Now button to upload it
- 7. Now you can active the Theme.

Install via FTP

To install a theme correctly, you **MUST UNZIP** the file provided by ThemeForest.

- 1. Locate Tersus folder i.e. Tersus-Wordpress/Tersus
- 2. The correct theme folder with have the style.css file within the root. i.e. Tersus/style.css
- 3. Open your FTP client and connect to your server.
- 4. Locate the themes directory e.g. '/wp-content/themes/'
- 5. Upload the Tersus folder to this directory, once the folder has uploaded it should read '/wp-content/themes/Tersus'
- 6. Log into the **WordPress** admin, go to **Appearance** \rightarrow **Themes** and activate the Theme.

Updating the Theme

As previously mentioned, the Envato plugin is the best method for installing the Theme, it allows you to create **backups** and **upgrade** the theme, however if you wish to upgrade via FTP, you can do the following.

- 1. Open your **FTP client** and connect to your server.
- 2. Locate the theme in the themes directory e.g. '/wp-content/themes/Tersus'
- 3. Make a backup if needed by downloading the current version of the Theme to your computer.
- 4. Upload the new **Tersus** folder to the exact same directory, overwriting the existing files.
- 5. Once completed the new version will already be active.

Important! When using content animator within a stage gallery you must set the Post \rightarrow Stage Gallery Options \rightarrow Gallery Image Content to **Image (Text Overlay)**

Important! Ensure the ID's **DO NOT** contain special characters. Underscores _ are allowed e.g. id="hello_text".

Phones & Tablets Code

Because of the varying sizes of devices - the content animator is disabled on Phone and Tablets with Galleries. However the following solution has been implmented to display a static image when using a Phone or Tablet device.

Insert this at the bottom of the Post/Gallery Media Post. Change the parameters to suit your needs.

Unzip the file from ThemeForest - the demo data is located within the folder Tersus-Wordpress/Demo-XML/tersus.wordpress.xml

If you have posts or comments in another system, WordPress can import those into this site. To get sta

If the importer you need is not listed, search the plugin directory to see if an importer is available.

Log-in to your WordPress admin, ensure the Theme is activated. Goto **Tools** \rightarrow **Import** \rightarrow Select WordPress



If required, download and active the WordPresss Importer plugin. Once activated you may need to repeat steps above.

Codestyling Localization

This Theme is translation ready, included with the theme is the required files for the translating the theme into any language. It's recommended that you use the **codestyling localization** plugin to help translate the theme.

The .mo / .po files are located in the theme/languages/ folder.

Migrating Language Files

If you have translated a previous version of the Theme and you wish to migrate the **old translations** into the new version of the theme, follow the guide below:

- 1. Locate the following folder on your server: /wp-content/theme/languages/
- 2. Copy both .mo and .po files e.g. **de_DE.mo , de_DE.po**
- 3. Upload them to your server within the new theme version **language directory** e.g. /wp-content/theme/**languages**
- 4. Ensure you have the codestyling localization plugin enabled
- 5. Goto the WP Admin \rightarrow Tools \rightarrow Localization \rightarrow Themes \rightarrow Locate Language \rightarrow Rescan \rightarrow Scan Now
- 6. Once the scan is complete, close the dialog box and click **Edit**, your translations should be present on the new version of the Theme.

If you wish to customise the Theme using CSS, add your CSS styles to Header Settings \rightarrow Add Custom CSS.

Theme / Skin Customizer

Create, Set, Edit Skins

Warning! Due to the WordPress customizer having a compatibility issue with **jQuery Tabs**, do not try to customize a page with tabs on.

To customize or create a new skin, goto Appearance \rightarrow Themes \rightarrow Customize \rightarrow Select Skin \rightarrow Edit the Skin you want or create a new one.

Alternatively:

Login to WordPress, visit the page you wish to **customize** on the front end (not within the admin) \rightarrow hover over the **Site Name** in admin menu (top left) \rightarrow click **customize**.

Edit / Create Skin Preset

Select the **Skin to Edit** option to edit an existing Skin. Once selected the Skin automatically loads into the settings.

To create a new Skin, select the **New** button. You must enter a **unique ID** into the **New Skin ID** field.

Set Default Skin

This option allows you to set a default skin pre-set for the entire site. This option can be overriden within Post / Pages \rightarrow Page / Post Skin Tab.

Duplicate Skin

To duplicate a skin, select the skin you wish to duplicate from the **Select Skin to Edit** select menu, once loaded click the **Duplicate** button \rightarrow Enter a **unique ID** into the **New Skin ID** \rightarrow click the **Save** button.

These settings control overall Frame of the Theme. It's recommend to load existing skin pre-sets to see examples of use.

Choose between Light or Dark.

Light has a background color of #FFFFFF Dark has a background color of #121212

Background Header / Main / Footer

This option allows you to control the background of the Header, Main, Footer areas.

Enabled displays the solid color as per color above. **Disabled** removes all background color and border **Border** displays the bottom border only. **Color** displays a color only.

A custom color can be set for Header, Main and Footer areas, select a color for the Top and Bottom part of the element and then make sure an opacity value is set. Select which branding version your skin requires. The Primary and Secondary branding options can be configured within **Theme Options** \rightarrow **Header** tab.

Font Settings

It's recommend to load existing skin pre-sets to see examples of use.

Font Sizes

Control the General, Heading and Menu font size.

Font Family

Control the Font Family for General, Headings, Menu.

The default Font type is set to **Google**, this option can be switched to **Cufon** within Theme Options \rightarrow General Settings.

General, Header, Footer

Control the general, link, link:hover and heading font colors for the General, Header and Footer areas. Click into the box and a color picker will be displayed for you to choose the color you require.

Background Layers

Build up different layers within the background.

- Upto 4 different layers to choose from.

- Layer 1 being the furthest back layer with layer 4 being on the top. This allows the user to build up a number of different effects in the background of the web page. Each Layer has the ability to contro the opacity levels.

Click on the 'Select Background Type' drop down box and the user will see six different customisation tools to choose from

Color

- User can pick a Primary and Secondary color from color picker tool.
- Can change opacity for both
- Opacity basically makes the object more translucent.

- A Secondary color is optional, completing both Primary and Secondary fields will display a gradient effect.

Fullscreen

- Makes an image display in fullscreen on the background.
- When the browser window changes size, the image will keep in proportion.
- Be cautious Too high resolution images = the image will be slow loading. Too low resolution = image to pixelate.
- Recommended image width is between 1200-2000px.
- User can also use a image URL if they do not have an image uploaded previous.
- The user can also add a color to the background. This color will show behind the background.

Image Positioned

- User can choose or upload an image and set the opacity, background color. This option also adds positioning and repeat.

- Images can be set to be positioned in a particular place in the background.

- Images can also be repeated across the background.

Pattern

- This allows the user to set a pattern to the background.

- There are 12 different backgrounds to choose from and each can have the opacity and background color set.

Video / Flash

- A video clip or flash file can run in the background of the page.
- User can set the video type from the drop down box. This could be YouTube to jwplayer.
- Video URL can also be added if a file has not previously been uploaded.
- Video Loop Yes makes the video loop and no makes the video play once.

Image / Video Cycle

- Slide time out timeout to next slide.
- Opacity and background color can also be changed.
- Select data source

Header Settings

To edit menu, branding alignment etc, goto WordPress \rightarrow Dashboard \rightarrow Customize This Theme \rightarrow Header

Branding Version

This option can be changed on each Skin and allows you to choose between a Primary and Secondary Branding / Logo (ideal if you have a light and dark skin which require different logos).

Minimum Header Height

Increase the header height by using this option, it sets a minimum height and not a static height, this way if the content exceeds the height it will automatically adjust itself.

Branding Display

Choose to hide the Branding / Logo, this is a global setting and affects the entire site.

Branding / Logo Alignment

Select the alignment of the branding - choose between Left, Right, Center.

Branding / Logo Top Margin

This option allows you to set a top margin value for the branding / logo, increase the value to push the logo down.

Menu Alignment

Select the menu alignment - choose between Left, Right, Center.

Menu Top Margin

This option allows you to set a top margin value for the menu, increase the value to push the menu down.

General Settings

If you wish to display the full desktop version of your website on all devices, go to Theme Options \rightarrow General Settings \rightarrow Disable Responsive Design

Pages Layout

Pages Layout

Select the default page layout for new pages.

Breadcrumbs

Globally Enable / Disable Breadcrumbs. If you leave this enabled you can disable on individual pages.

Page Comments

Enable commenting on Pages.

Show Author Bio

Enable Author Bio information on Posts only, Posts & Pages or disable globally.

Sidebars

Sidebars

This option allows you to select how many sidebars you wish to create. Default is Two. See Wordpress Admin \rightarrow Appearance \rightarrow Widgets once you have entered the amount of sidebars you require.
Font Type

Visit Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow General \rightarrow Typography and choose between Cufon, Google or Normal Fonts. By default Google fonts are used, the selected font type will display a pre-selected list of fonts within the Customizer \rightarrow Font Settings.

Custom Cufon Font

Add a custom Cufon font by downloading a Cufon javascript file from example <u>cufonfonts.com</u> - the file can be uploaded via the **Media Library** - copy and paste the URL into the **Appearance** \rightarrow **Theme Options** \rightarrow **General** \rightarrow **Custom Cufón Font** field.

The new font will appear within the Appearance \rightarrow Themes \rightarrow Customize \rightarrow Font Settings \rightarrow Headings Font Family list.

Custom Google Fonts

Add upto two custom Google Fonts. Once the fields have been completed the new fonts will appear within the **Appearance** \rightarrow **Themes** \rightarrow **Customize** \rightarrow **Font Settings** \rightarrow **Headings Font Family**. See the steps below for how to add extra fonts.

- 1. Copy the URL Name e.g. Noto+Sans
- 2. Copy the CSS name e.g. Noto Sans

Add Google Font Step 3 Custom Google Font One Noto+Sans Noto Sans

Goto your WordPress admin \rightarrow Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow General Tab \rightarrow Google Fonts

- 1. Paste the URL Name e.g. Noto+Sans into the URL Name field
- 2. Paste the CSS Name e.g. Noto Sans into the CSS Name field

Tersus 2.0.x / DynamiX 3.0.x

As of **Tersus 2.0.1** and **DynamiX 3.0**, only the JW Player WordPress plugin is needed.

- 1. Goto WordPress admin \rightarrow Plugins \rightarrow Add New
- 2. Search for JW Player
- 3. Click 'Install Now' on 'JW Player for WordPress Flash & HTML5 Video Player'
- 4. Now upload and your video URL's to either:
- 5. Slide Sets Manager \rightarrow Media \rightarrow Media URL or
- 6. **Posts** → **Gallery / Media** tab → **Media URL** and choose the JW Player **Embed Media** option

Tersus 1.x > 2.0 / DynamiX 2.x

Warning! Tersus 1.x to 2.0 is not compatible with JW Player 6.x, **use the following download** to allow these versions to work with JW Player.

To play most Video / Audio formats with this Theme it's recommended to use the JW Player embed option.

JW Player can be embedded into the Grid, Stage, iSlider, Accordion, Group Slider Galleries and the Video Shortcode.

- 1. Login to WordPress → Goto Appearance → Theme Options → General → Scroll to JW Player Configuration.
- Click the Media Library Button → Locate the downloaded JW Player files on your computuer and Upload jwplayer.js and player.swf only → Once uploaded COPY the URL of both files into the relevant Fields. e.g.

JW Player **Javascript** URL would contain something like: PATH-TO-YOUR-FILE/**jwplayer.js** JW Player **Flash** URL would contain something like: PATH-TO-YOUR-FILE/**player.swf**

JW Player Video Lightbox

Note: Currently this is not possible with JW Player 6.0.

To play JW Player within lightboxes specify the path of your JW Player flash file (See above for uploading the flash file)

e.g. /wp-content/uploads/2011/03/player.swf

Then add the video path using the file variable.

e.g. ?ffile=/wp-content/uploads/2011/03/InsideJob-Sample.mp4

So the full path looks similar to the following. (note! this is just an example - you'll need to

modify to represent the paths to your own files).

/wp-content/uploads/2011/03/player.swf?file=/wp-content/uploads/2011/03/InsideJob-Sample.mp

Check the autoplay check option within Posts / Gallery Media Posts -> Embed Media / Timeout Options.

Flickr API

Add your Flickr details to enable the option to add Flickr Sets to your Galleries as a datasource. Once the details have been completed and saved the Gallery Data Source will display a Flickr option and display your Flickr Sets to choose from.

Flick User ID

You're required to enter your Flickr User ID e.g. XXXXXX@NO2. Use this tool to find your User ID

Select the default layout for Blog pages. This includes Index and Archive pages.

Column Sidebars

Select a sidebar which is relative to the column. Add more sidebars via the Theme Options \rightarrow General tab

Layout Format

Choose between Normal and Grid format for displaying your Posts.

Grid Columns

If the Layout format is set to Grid, choose the number of columns you wish to display the Posts in.

Post Content

By default this is set to Excerpt Only, to display an Excerpt + Image, set the option here, this setting can be overriden via $Posts \rightarrow Additional \rightarrow Image in Post / Archive$

Display Post Metadata

If you wish to hide categories, dates and other metadata, select the option here.

Choose between displaying the metadata to the left of the post or below the title.

Blog Page / Single Post Images

These settings are within Theme Options \rightarrow Blog Settings

Image Align

Select the alignment of the blog image, choose from left, right and center (default).

Image Lightbox

If set to **Off** the Post will link the Image to the set link – Set to **On** the image will display within a lightbox when clicked.

Image Effect

Select the effect you want to apply to the image.

Enter a width value for all the images to be set by. This will automatically determine the height of the image if the height field is left blank.

Image Height (Optional)

Enter a height value along with the Width value to crop an image.

NOTE

The settings above do NOT affect Full Post Content Type.

Header Settings

Drop Panel / Search

Drop Panel

Enable or Disable the Drop Panel option. By default the Drop Panel is enabled.

Drop Panel Columns

Select upto 4 columns for the Drop Panel area. Drag and drop widgets into the columns within WP \rightarrow Appearance \rightarrow Widgets \rightarrow Drop Panel Columns

Search

Enable or Disable the search section, by default this option is Enabled.

If content is added to the Infobar it will automatically appear at the top of all pages. The Infobar can also be enabled for individual pages, see page options.

Content

The content can contain HTML and Shortcodes.

Branding Image

Branding Image

If you wish to upload your logo, please enter the URL of your image. Alternatively if you haven't uploaded one already select the Upload button and upload your logo to the media library then copy the URL of the image in the box.

If this is left empty the theme will automatically display the Blog Title and Tagline – set in Settings \rightarrow General.

Branding Image (Primary) URL

The Primary branding option is your default Branding. It can be selected from within the Appearance \rightarrow Themes \rightarrow Customize \rightarrow Header \rightarrow Branding Version.

Branding Image (Secondary) URL

The secondary option is useful if for example, a dark skin setting is present and the primary branding option is not suitable.

Wordpress Custom Menu / Extended Menu

This option is enabled by default and requires WP 3.0 or greater. To configure, goto WP Admin \rightarrow Appearance \rightarrow Menus \rightarrow Create your menu and select your Custom Menu in the top left hand corner (Theme Locations).

Drop Panel Menu Item

To initiate the Drop Panel using WP Custom Menu, got to WP Admin \rightarrow Appearance \rightarrow Menus and click "Screen Options" (Top Right) and switch on "CSS Classes". Now create a new Custom Link with the URL left as http:// and give the link a name e.g. Contact Us.

Once the link is added to the menu, you need to remove the URL and paste droppaneltrigger into the CSS Classes field. Now your menu item will act as a drop panel trigger.

Main Menu Description

To add a menu description simply add text to the "Title Attribute".

Extended Menu

The Extended Menu allows the user to have more than one column within the drop down menus.

To enable this feature, make sure the user has 'Wordpress Custom Menus' enabled. If unsure, navigate to 'Header Settings' and find 'Wordpress Custom Menus' and enable it.

After this, navigate to Apperance \rightarrow Menus.

Click on 'Screen Options' at the top right of the page and check the box for 'CSS Classes'. Close 'Screen Options'

To enable Extended Menus, click on a top menu and add in the correct text, as stated below. CSS Classes can only be added to the top menus.

By default there is 1 column. By adding in the text 'extended-menu' this enables a second column. Add 'three-columns' after this to have a total of 3 columns. E.g extended-menu three-columns. The column width is 200px.

If you want to change the alignment of the menu add a space followed by center or right to align the menu how you require it.

Enabling Descriptions

To enable descriptions, go to 'Screen Options' within 'Menus' and check the Descriptions check box. Go back into General Settings \rightarrow WordPress Custom Menu \rightarrow Enable WP Custom Menu Descriptions and check Enable. This will allow descriptions to be shown. Save and continue.

By default, WordPress automatically assigns a description. To remove this, naviagate back to Apperance \rightarrow Menus and expand the desired child menu. Delete the exsisting description and add your own in. This could be an image gallery shortcode for example. Once descriptions are enabled, each child menu will have a description. The user will have to go through and delete the unwanted descriptions. Not all shortcodes are designed to be placed within the Extended Menus.

Custom HTML / Shortcode

Enter custom HTML code into the text box and it will appear within the header section of the site.

Adding a Favicon

A favicon is the small icon that appears to the left of the address within the address bar.

To add a favicon simply enter the URL of your image. It can be in either .ico or .png format.

Tracking / Head Scripts

Place your google **analytics code** or any other code that requires to be placed within the **<head>** and before the closing **</head>** tag into the following location:

Footer Settings

Footer Options

Display Footer

Globally Enable / Disable the Footer area. The footer can also be disabled on individual pages, see Page Options for more information.

Select Number of Columns

By default the Footer is split into 4 columns - this can be adjusted by changing this option.

Lower Footer Options

The Lower Footer can be disabled if required.

This area can contain text and HTML in both left and right sections. This is also an ideal place to enter your Google Analytics Code.

Note. To remove the **designed by NorthVantage** text from the lower right, insert your own text into Lower Footer Right or add a blank HTML element like the following to make it blank.

Social Media Options

Goto Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow Social Media

Enable Social Icons

Social lcons can be enabled Globally via this tab, set the lcon(s), Color and Share lcon. These settings can be overriden on a Page by Page basis.

Goto Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow Social

Social Media Button Links

If you want to use the social media buttons, you must add your own URL into the boxes and then enable them within pages.

Leave the fields blank to restore default URL's.

Main RSS Feed

Enter your own RSS feed URL into the box and it will appear on every page.

This RSS feed is for the whole website. If you want to have an RSS feed for a specific page, you would need to enter your RSS feed URL into the social media button links, as mentioned above, and then enable it within pages.

To add a title to your RSS feed, simply type in your desired title into the 'Main RSS Title' box.

Twitter

Twitter

Enter your Twitter account details and how many tweets you wish to display. The theme will cycle through your latest tweets.

The Twitter Feed can be enabled per page, under Pages \rightarrow Social \rightarrow Twitter Feed

To configure the Page / Post layout, goto the Page / Post \rightarrow Page Config tab.

As the diagram above suggests, enter an alternative Title or enter the text **BLANK** to override / disable the page title completely.

Sub Title

Enter a page Sub Title if required, this will appear directly underneath the main Page Title.

Page Layout

You can the global page layout via Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow General \rightarrow Page Layout, you can also set the layout on a Page by Page basis using this option.

Column Sidebars

Depending on the page layout you select, choose a Sidebar that corresponds to the column. You can add sidebars via Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow General

Display / Disable Header

This option allows you to disable the header on that particular page.

Branding / Menu Alignment

Control the alignment of the Branding and Menu for this page only.

Disable Breadcrumbs

Disable the breadcrumbs from displaying on this page only.

Disable Main Content

This option allows you to hide the page content, this is ideal if you wish to just display a Gallery on the page without any other text/content.

Disable Main Frame Background

Use this to disable the main frame which surrounds the page content. Ideal if you wish to format the page differently – You can use the Visual Composer \rightarrow Styled Boxes \rightarrow General to add the same border type around selected content.

Disable Footer

Select this option to disable the Footer on this page only.

Breadcrumbs

Breadcrumbs can be globally enabled via Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow General and disable on a page by page basis using the disable breadcrumbs option

Publish Author Name / Date

Selecting these options will display the Publish Date and Author Name on the page.

Text Resizer

Enable the text resizer on an individual page by switching this option to on.

Selecting a gallery will present options that relate to that particular Gallery type.

Gallery Data Source

See Gallery Data Sources for more information on each type of data source available (Slide Sets are the recommended option).

Image Effects

Each gallery can be customised by adding Image effects to each image displayed. Add a shadow + reflection, reflection, drop shadow, frame or black & white or no effect.

Enable Lightbox

Depending on the gallery requirements, Lightbox can be enabled – this display the full size image within a lightbox or if a video is defined in the media url for that slide / post it will display the video in the lightbox. Alternatively the image can link to a specific URL.

CSS Classes within a gallery

This feature takes your custom skin and applies it to your specified gallery. Create custom styles using the additional style option within the Skin Manager and copy the style name into the CSS Classes box.

Image Width

It's good practice to enter a width value, the height can be automatically set from this value.

Image Height

If you wish to crop an image, set both a width and height, the image will not disort.

Gallery / Row Height

This option defines the Gallery height or if the Grid Gallery option is select, it acts as a height for the individual row.

Slide Timeout

Timeout to the next slide. Applies to Stage, 3d, Accordion, GroupSilder, iSlider and Nivo galleries. Default is 10.

Gallery Content

This option allows you to choose what to display in those galleries. A choice of Text Image, Title Image, Title Overlay Image, Title & Text Overlay Image, Image Only, Text Only. Title Overlay Image and Title & Text Overlay Image reveal the Title/ Description Text when the image is hovered over.

Stage, Nivo Gallery Navigation

Control your gallery slides with an optional navigation. The user can add Bullet Nav + Left/Right Nav, Bullet Nav or disable all Nav.

Group Slider / Grid Gallery Position

the option is available to display the gallery above or below the main content.

Excerpt Word Limit

Limit the amount of words you want the gallery to display. Default is 55 words.

Limit Number of Posts to Display

Limit the number of posts retrieved from the database. This option also works with Attached Media

Sort By and Order By

Control how the posts are retrieved from the database. This option also works with Attached Media

Accordion Gallery Options

Accordion Auto Rotate

Enable to auto rotate through each accordion panel. Set the timeout using the Slide Timeout option

Accordion Startup Mini Titles

This option is enabled by default, it displays the Title overlaying each image when the gallery has loaded.

Group Slider & Grid Gallery Options

Grid / Group Slider Columns

Enter the number of columns you want to display on a single row.

Grid Gallery Show Posts

For use with Posts only, paginate how many posts to display on a page. 6 is default.

Grid Gallery Category Filter

Enable for animated category filtering. Select more than one Post category or create Gallery Slide Set filter tags (See Slide Set Manager screencast). Pagination will be disabled. Ideal for a portfolio.

If a category is clicked, the gallery is animated to filter only the Images within that category.

Group Slider Image Alignment

Alignment of the Group Slider - Choose from either Centre, Left or Right.

Group Slider Layout Format

Layout Format for the Group Slider - Choose from either Horizontal or Vertical.

Nivo Options

Nivo Transition Effect

Control the transition effect from one image to the next.

Stage Gallery Options

Slide Transition

The animation transition in which the images will change from one to the next.

Tweening

The process of generating intermediate frames between two images. It's recommended to try one or two to see the effect.

3d Gallery Options

Pieces

Number of pieces to which the image is sliced. Default is 15

Transition

Choose from various Tweener effects.

Transition Time

Time for one cube to turn. Default is 1.2.

Delay

Delay between the start of one cube to the start of the next cube. Default is 0.1.

DepthOffset

The offset during transition on the z-axis. Value between 100 and 1000 are recommended. But go for experiments.

CubeDistance

The distance between the cubes during transition. Values between 5 and 50 are recommended. But go for experiments.

The width of the image for the Stage Gallery should be at least 940px.

Controls X Position

Controls the position of the gallery horizontally the page.

Controls Y Position

Controls the position of the gallery vertically the page.

Text Background Color

Change the background colour of the 3d gallery using the color picker tool.

Text Color

Change the text color of the 3d gallery.
Social Options

Social Options

Social Options allows you to add various Social Networking links to your Page or Post. It also allows you to add a **Twitter Feed** to the page – this will cycle through your latest tweets. See Theme Options \rightarrow Social Media Options \rightarrow Twitter to configure.

Twitter can be placed either above or beneath the content.

Social Networking icons can also be placed within the content of the Page/Post.

Disable Share Icon

Selecting this option will display the Social Networking icons directly on the page without the "Share" graphic.

Header Infobar

The header infobar allows you to add content to a page which displays directly above the header area. This can be set globally or on individual pages and can contain HTML / shortcodes.

Introduction Text

This allows you to add custom content which is placed directly under the page titles. If the Override Page Title text is set to BLANK it will display the Introduction content only. HTML and shortcodes are supported.

Exit Text

This content is displayed directly beneath the main content area. HTML and shortcodes are supported.

Page templates can be selected from Pages \rightarrow Page Attributes \rightarrow Template. Choose from the following

Blog Template

The **Blog** template and **Grid Blog** (Grid Blog columns can be set in Appearance \rightarrow Theme Options \rightarrow Blog) display the latest posts on a page.

Select the categories you want to display from Pages \rightarrow Blog \rightarrow Categories.

If you wish to filter post formats, this can be done by selecting the formats you wish to disable.

This template also acts as a normal page and content can be placed above your blog posts e.g. a gallery.

Note! If the blog categories are not working, ensure the WP \rightarrow Settings \rightarrow Reading \rightarrow Posts Page is set to blank.

Sitemap

Select the sitemap template to display Pages, Posts, Categories etc.

Page / Post Skin

The global Skin option is set in Appearance \rightarrow Themes \rightarrow Customize \rightarrow Default Skin.

Page Skin

You can override the default Skin option by selecting a Skin via Pages / Post \rightarrow Skin tab.

Note! If you wish to use a particular Post within a Gallery, you can set the various options via this Tab. To use the Post within a Gallery, save the Post into a specific Category and select that Category within Pages \rightarrow Add Gallery \rightarrow Data Source \rightarrow Post Categories.

Image URL

This option only applies if you do not wish to use the **Featured Image** (Post Thumbnail), this option overrides the Featured Image.

Click the Upload File button to insert the image URL.

If you do not enter an image into this field and there is no Featured Image set, the Galleries will automatically detect the first image in the post and use that.

Media URL

As with the Image File, click the **Upload File** button to insert the image URL. This can be a local Video / Audio URL, YouTube, Vimeo or other kind.

Embed Media

To display a video on a page or gallery slide, set this option, if lightbox is selected on the Gallery and you wish for the video to play within the lightbox, ensure this option is set to **Disabled.**

Video Ratio

Set the video ratio that best suits your media.

Autoplay Media

Enabling this option will auto play the video within the gallery slide.

Stage Gallery

Slide Timeout

This option overrides the default timeout setting for this slide only. For example if the default time for all slides is 10 seconds and you enter 30 seconds in this option, this slide only will display for 30 seconds.

Gallery Image Content

This option allows you to set how the content is shown in the Stage gallery.

- Image Displays the image only
- Image / Text Overlay (Left) Overlays the post content / description over the image with shaded background
- Image / Text Overlay (Right) Overlays the post content / description over the image with shaded background
- Image / Title Overlay (Hover) Overlays the title over the image with shaded background when hovered over
- Image / Text Overlay (Hover) Overlays the post content / description over the image with shaded background when hovered over
- **Image / Text Overlay** Overlays the post content / description over the image (to be used with the content animator)

Post Title Overlay

If you wish to overlay the gallery image with the Post Title / Post Sub Title text, select an option from this list. There are various options to suit the image the text is overlaying, including light or dark text.

Additional (Post Only)

Alternative Link

This allows you to link the post to an alternative URL (Within your website or external). e.g. The image advertises a Service – link the image to a Services page.

Disable Link

Disable the Post linking.

Disable Read More

This option removes the "Read More" text but still allows the post image/title to link.

Image in Post & Archive

If you wish to display your Image File as part of the post in the Archive and Single Post pages then select this option. If this option is enabled it will display the image within the post and enable the Lightbox effect. If you have a Video file also associated with the post it will use the Image as a thumbnail and then open the video within the Lightbox.

CSS Classes

Add custom CSS Classes to your galleries. e.g. add target_blank to open the link URL in a new window.

Individual vs Attached Media

You can use Gallery Media Post types in two ways.

Individual

Each Gallery Media Post can act as an individual gallery slide e.g. an image. See below for more information.

Pros

You can control each slide specifically with timeout options for Stage, embed Vimeo/YouTube videos etc.

Cons

Slow method if you require to add a vast amount of images.

Attached

Each Gallery Media Post can act as a host to many images/media by attaching the media to that Gallery Media Post. See **Attached Media** for more information.

Pros

A very fast method of adding a vast amount of images/media to a Gallery.

Cons

Limited control of individual slides e.g. Only Title and Description can be modified via WordPress \rightarrow Media.

You can attach individual images by clicking Attach under the Attached to column.

Alternatively click the **Unattached** tab \rightarrow Check (click select icon) for all the images you want to attach \rightarrow Bulk Actions \rightarrow Attach to a post \rightarrow Apply \rightarrow Search for your Page / Post \rightarrow Click Select.

Customize

Custom CSS

This option is ideal if custom CSS is required, this option is not affected by Theme upgrades.

Add Mobile CSS

If you wish to add mobile CSS (responive mode needs to be enabled) you can do using this field.

Add Javascript

If you wish to add jQuery or javascript to your site, use this field. It will load the script at the end of the page in the footer.

BuddyPress / bbPress

Note! You DO NOT need to install any template compatibility plugins.

BuddyPress / bbPress Plugin

This Theme supports the BuddyPress and bbPress Plugin, this allows you to use your WP site as usual but with the added features of BuddyPress and bbPress. To activate the plugins, download the BuddyPress / bbPress plugin via the Wordpress Admin \rightarrow Plugins \rightarrow Add New.

Woocommerce / WP e-Commerce

Woocommerce / WP e-Commerce Plugin

This Theme is designed to integrate with the Woocommerce & WP e-Commerce plugins. Download and activate the Woocommerce or WP e-Commerce plugin. Once activated the Theme will automatically enable functionality.

A cart icon will appear top right of the Header section and a new Gallery Data Source is activated to allow products to be placed with Galleries.
